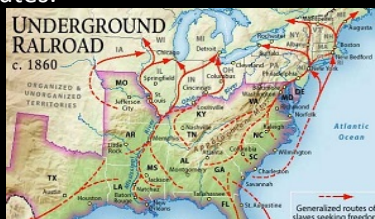

Tuskegee Airmen: An all African-American pursuit squadron based in Tuskegee, Alabama, in 1941. They became known as the Tuskegee Airmen.



Underground Railroad: A network of secret routes and safe houses used by 19th century enslaved people of African descent in the U.S in efforts to escape to free states.



The Great Migration: The largest internal movement of any group in U.S. history between the years of 1910 to 1970. 6,000,000 African Americans left the rural south to other U.S. states.
