Community Development Block Grant Funding Now Available Deadline for Submission is Monday, April 8

March 11, 2019

Non-profit agencies serving low to moderate-income residents in the City of Palm Springs can now register to receive federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) entitlement funds. The deadline for submission is **3 p.m. on Monday, April 8.**

The City is expected to receive \$421,112 in funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, (HUD), for distribution beginning July 1, 2019. The money can be used for capital projects or to fund community services.

Any non-profit group interested in obtaining a slice of the funds should submit a "Request for Proposal" packet available online at <https://zoomgrants.com/gprop.asp?donorid=2321&limited=2228>.

A workshop to help applicants through the process will be held at **9 a.m. on March 29 in the Large Conference Room at City Hall, 3200 E. Tahquitz Canyon Way.**

The CDBG Citizens Advisory Committee will additionally conduct an April 10 public hearing for oral presentations from applicants. The committee will make recommendations to the City Council in late April about which programs should receive funding. The Council is expected to make a final decision in early May.
