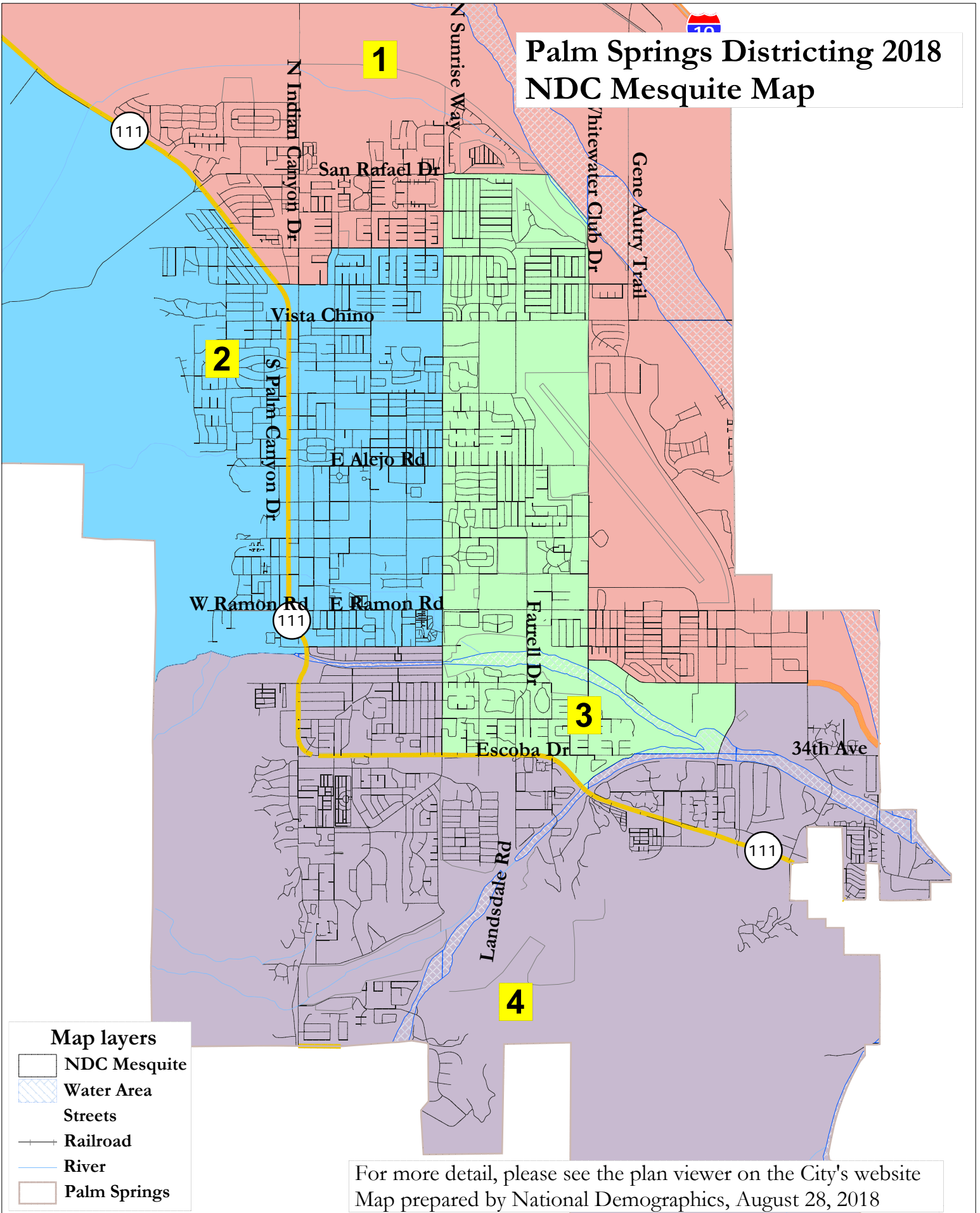








Palm Springs Districting 2018 NDC Mesquite Map
