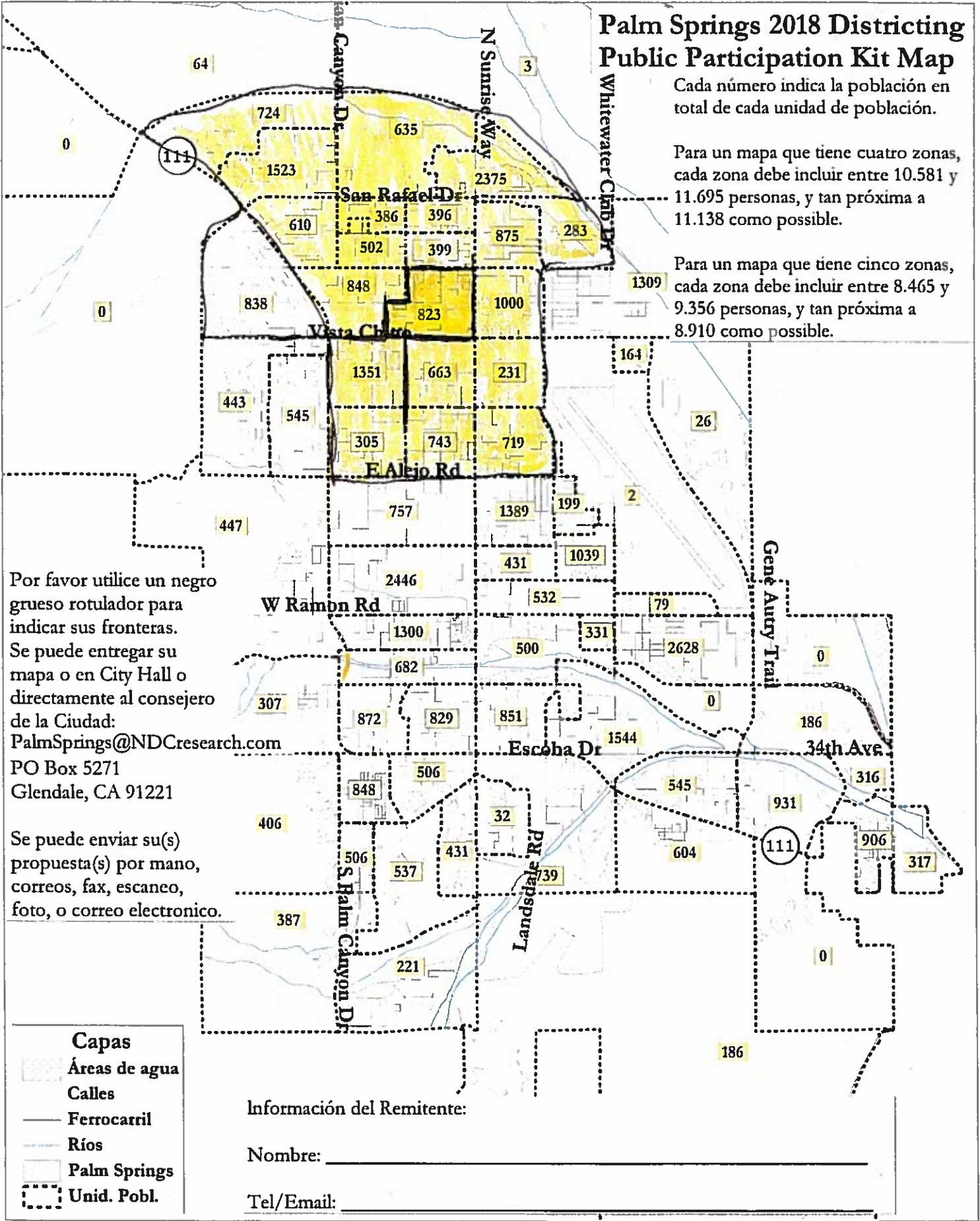


# Palm Springs 2018 Districting Public Participation Kit Map

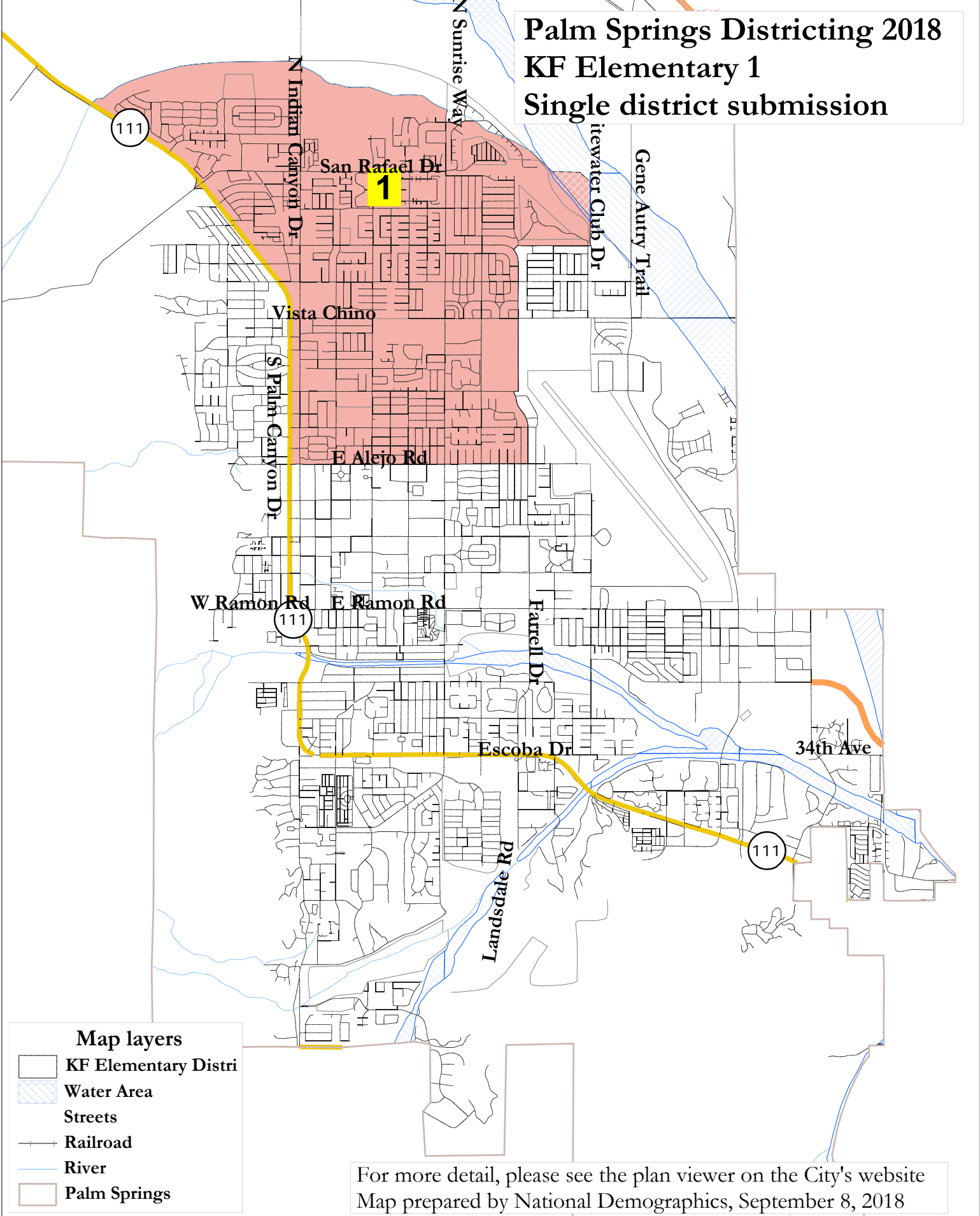
