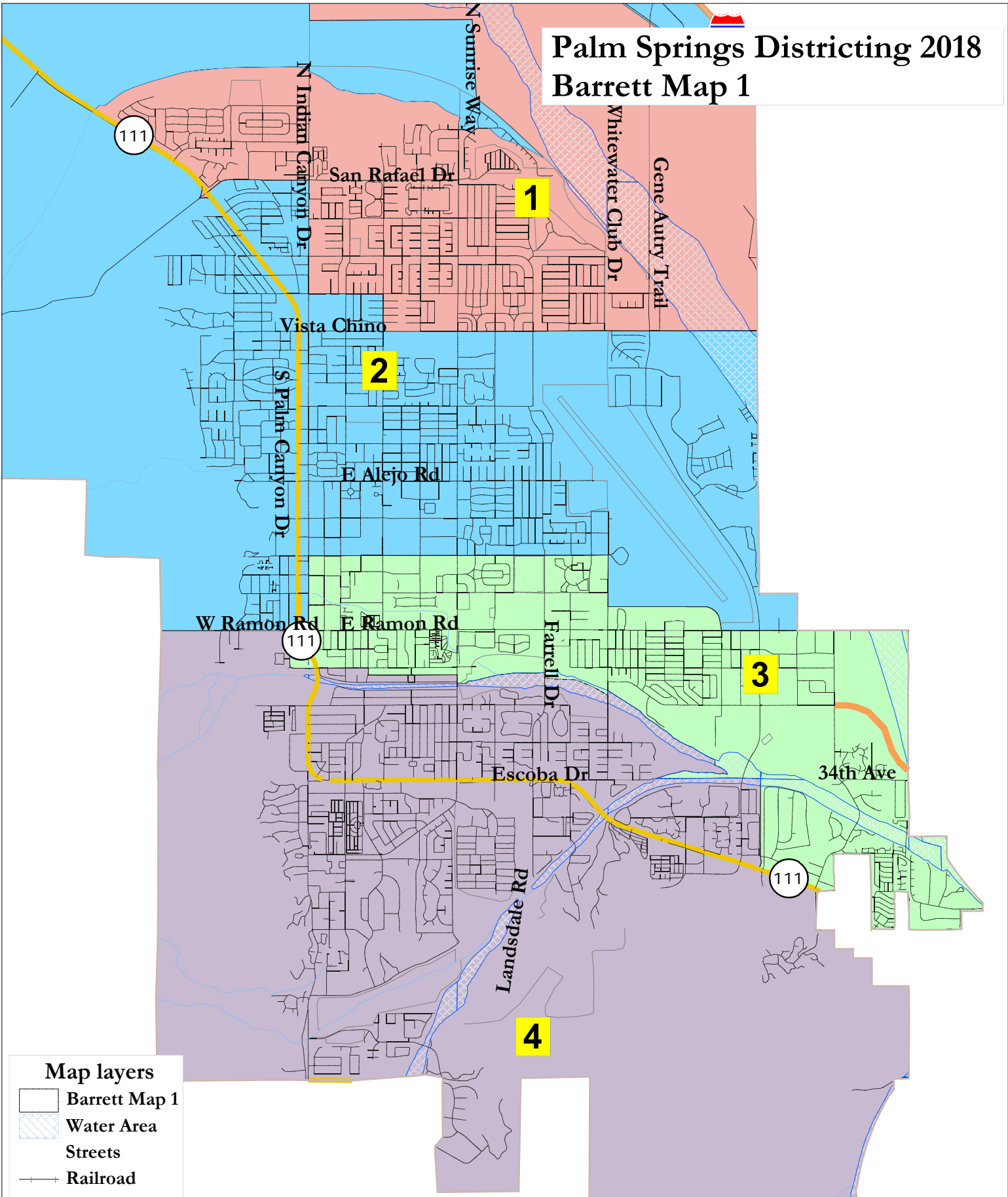








Barrett Map 1 description
