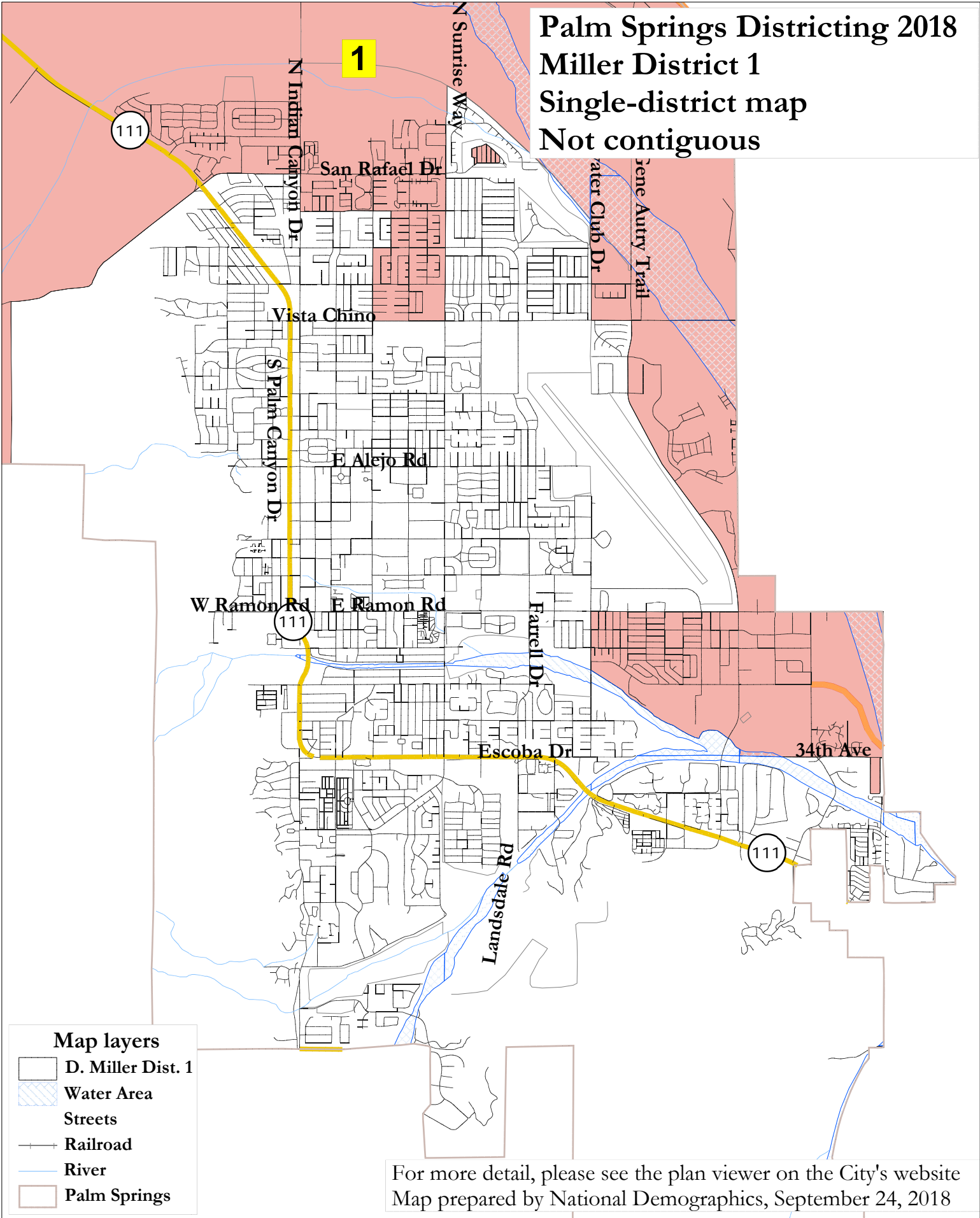


**Palm Springs Districting 2018
