**Palm Springs City Council Outlook for Wednesday, Oct. 17, 2018**

A public hearing regarding a development agreement for a new 126-acre residential project called “Serena Park” located on land that was formerly the Palm Springs Country Club, a proposed extension of an interim urgency ordinance that would allow a temporary moratorium on demolition and alteration of Class 3 Historic structures before 1969 -- and consideration of an agreement with Sunline Transit Agency for the operation and management of the BUZZ Trolley system, will be some of the noteworthy items on the agenda at Wednesday night’s Palm Springs City Council meeting.
