

RESOLUTION NO. 24464

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM SPRINGS, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON JUNE 5, 2018, DECLARING THE RESULTS, AND OTHER SUCH MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Palm Springs, California, on Tuesday, June 5, 2018, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form, and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received, and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California and City Charter for the holding of elections; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 24382, the Riverside County Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM SPRINGS, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the ballot measure submitted to the voters is as follows:

Shall the City of Palm Springs prohibit vacation rentals in single family residences?	Yes
	No

SECTION 2. That the whole number of ballots cast in the precincts except vote by mail ballots and provisional ballots was 3,285.

That the whole number of vote by mail voter ballots cast in the City was 12,095, making a total of 15,380 ballots cast in the City.

SECTION 3. That as a result of the election, a majority of voters voting on Measure C relating to the prohibition of vacation rentals in single family residences did not vote in favor of it, and that the measure was not carried, and shall not be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City of Palm Springs, a statement of the results of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) The measure voted upon; (3) The number of votes given at each precinct for and against the measure; and (4) The total number of votes given for and against the measure.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk of the City of Palm Springs shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and its approval by the City Council and shall cause the same to be listed in the records of the City.
