Celebration of Newly Remodeled Fire Station No. 4**

Fire Station No. 4 in South Palm Springs is now remodeled, expanded and state-of-the-art thanks to Measure J tax dollars!

Palm Springs residents are invited to join the City Council and the Palm Springs Fire Department for a special celebration ribbon-cutting and open house on **Tuesday, July 23.**

The 9 a.m. event will take place at the Fire Station, located at 1300 S. Laverne Way. In addition, the Twin Palms neighborhood organization will present the Palm Springs Fire Department with a \$1,500 check for a new built-in barbeque.

The station, built in 1971 and originally designed by well-known mid-century modern architect Hugh Kaptur, had long been in need of updating to meet modern fire service demands in order to better serve the Palm Springs community.

“With the passage of voter-approved Measure J, capital improvement projects such as the expansion and remodel of Fire Station No. 4 are possible,” said City Manager David H. Ready. “The City Council and the Palm Springs firefighters would like to thank our residents for their foresight in voting to approve Measure J tax dollars for important citywide capital projects that enhance public safety and improve our quality of life.”
