Re: New Policy for Grading Certifications

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Engineering Services will be implementing a new policy regarding Grading Certifications. This new policy will not replace the current Pad Certifications currently required by our Building and Safety Department.

The Policy is to ensure that the Grading Operations (Grading, Drainage and inspections) will be reviewed by Engineering Services and Grading Certifications will now be required for projects that are associated with a Precise or Rough Grading Plan prior to issuance of a Building Permit.

No forms, ground plumbing or dry utilities will be allowed to be installed prior to the Grading Certification.

As indicated on the form below Grading Certifications will be required to have general site information, Engineer and/or Surveyors information, signature and Stamp. Geotechnical Company information and compaction report (90% or higher), Pad Elevation, Benchmark Information and final sign off from Engineering Services Inspector which will verify that the Certification is in compliance with the approved Plans.

Implementation of the Grading Certifications will be July 1, 2018. Fillable forms will be available on line at the City of Palm Springs Website:
