Limit three normal size file containers of shredding per vehicle. Size of container should be no larger than 9" X 13" X 17". Recycling available on a first come, first served basis or until trucks are full.

Protect Yourself Against Identity Theft - Protect yourself and destroy unneeded documents containing confidential information at the City's FREE document shredding event.



Electronic Equipment - All electronic equipment received at the event is dismantled and recycled. Any information stored on hard drives or cell phones is destroyed during the processing.



What Can You Bring?

Computers & Monitors – Microwaves and small appliances – Keyboards, Printers & Televisions, Cell Phones & Fax Machines

Due to COVID-19 Restrictions, please place all of your recycling and shredding in the trunk or back end of your vehicle. When you arrive, please have a mask on and stay in your vehicle. Pop your trunk or rear hatch when asked. Your recycling will be removed from you vehicle by our workers. Please keep your shredding and e-waste separate for more convenient and time saving processing.

On Saturday, October 17, 2020 at the end of Clean-Up Week, PSDS will position large debris boxes in the North parking lot of City Hall between the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. for Palm Springs residents to self-haul and dispose of Extra Household Waste and Bulky Items.

- There is no limit to the amount of waste or bulky items brought to the site and no charge for this service.
- PSDS personnel will assist the elderly and those with a physical disability with off-loading debris.
- Waste from commercial establishments is not accepted. Proof of residency may be required.

Hazardous waste is NOT accepted.
