## **Palm Springs City Council Outlook for Thursday, Oct. 8, 2020**

An update regarding Planning Commission recommendations to the General Plan vision statement and priorities, consideration of an urgency ordinance that would establish limitations on third-party food delivery fees, and review of turf conversion conceptual project designs for Palm Springs International Airport, will be some of the noteworthy items on the agenda at Thursday night's Palm Springs City Council meeting.
