SUMMARY

The City Council will consider the appointment of the City of Indio representative to the Palm Springs International Airport Commission.

RECOMMENDATION:

Appoint Jack Horner, as the City of Indio representative, to the Palm Springs International Airport Commission for the unexpired term ending June 30, 2013.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

In November, 2007, the City Council amended the Palm Springs Municipal Code to provide that each representative City nominate, and the Palm Springs City Council appoint the representative member to the Palm Springs International Airport Commission.


The City has received notification from the City of Indio of their nomination of Jack Horner, as the City of Indio representative to the Commission, for the term ending June 30, 2013.
