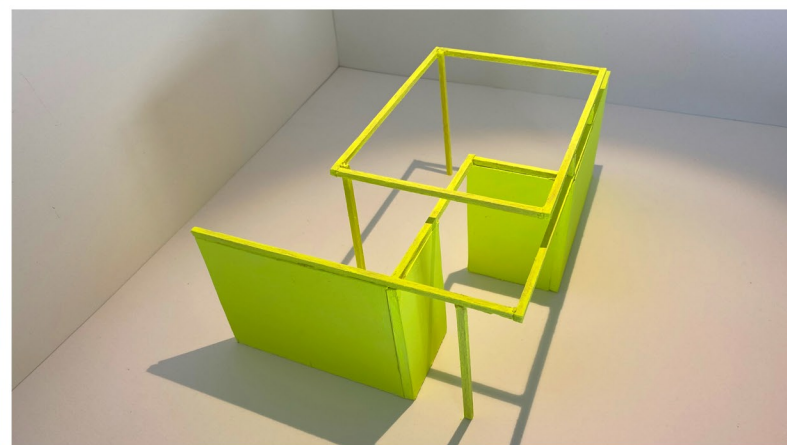
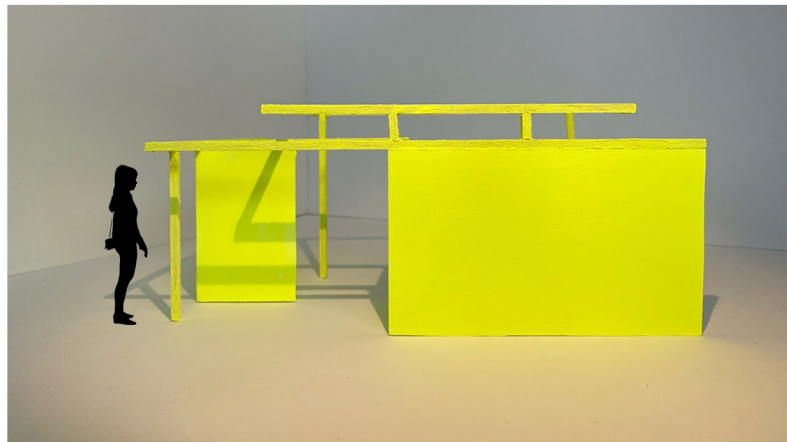
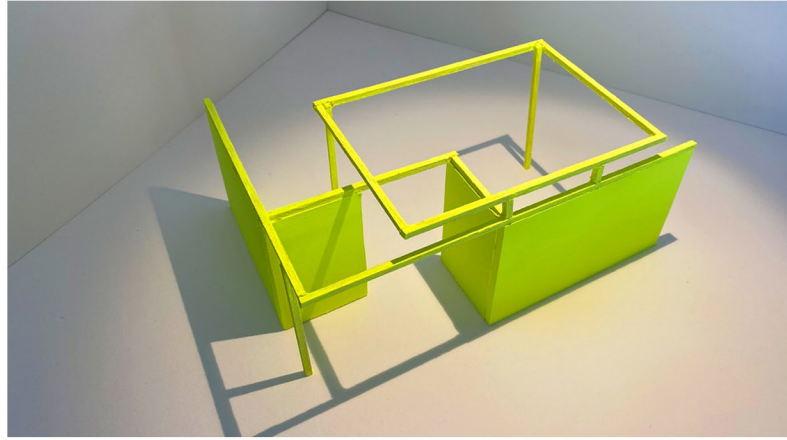

SHADE STUDY

Shade Study is a sculptural abstraction of the famed Mid Century Modern architecture of Palm Springs, featuring lines and shapes distilled to their purest form. As you walk around the structure, its panels, beams and shadows seem to visually shift to form “Beautiful Shade” from all angles. Made of fixed industrial steel and painted bright neon yellow, *Shade Study* contrasts the arid desert landscape, and stands out like a ghostly outline of a MCM structure.

Size: Approximately 8’ tall with a 16’ x 12’ foot print (site specific/dependent)

Construction: Made of industrial steel, sourced and fabricated locally in Palm Springs. Designed to meet all building codes with plans to be certified by a licensed structural engineer.

Method of attachment: To be placed and affixed permanently to flat, level concrete pad, grass, or desert area by the artist’s professional crew.

Durability: Permanent, resilient and safe against touch, wind and extreme weather.

Accessibly: Accessible to all at ground level.
